

Pyrus calleryana

‘Chanticleer’ *(Ornamental Pear)*

- The *Pyrus calleryana* Chanticleer was bred by Edward Scanlon in the USA.
- The tree grows white flowers in April/May
- Leaves arrive early spring and turn a bright orangey red in autumn.
- The leaves last longer than other trees, falling late autumn.
- The tree’s shape when mature is similar to a flame.
- Although the tree can occasionally produce small fruits, they are not for human consumption.
- It is tolerant of pollution and is often planted in urban areas.



Height when mature: **12-17m metres**

Time to grow to full height: **20-50 years**

Flower colour: **White**
